Determination:

Based on the uncontested evidence of the Appellant, the Tribunal finds that she is entitled to a redundancy lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003, based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth: Date employment commenced: Date employment ended: Gross weekly salary 17 May 1950 15 October 1990 30 January 2008 €199.20

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period. (The Tribunal notes that two separate redundancy

payments have already been made to the appellant up to 17 April 1996).

It also awards her €1,593.60 (being the equivalent of 8 weeks pay) under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2001.
