The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:

The claimant worked with the respondent from the 12 April 2007 to the 24 January 2008. On the 24 January 2008 he was told there was no further work for him. The claimant was not paid his statutory entitlement of one week's notice.

Determination:

On the uncontested evidence of the claimant the Tribunal is satisfied that his employment ended without notice and he is therefore entitled to €486.00, which is equivalent to one week's gross pay under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2001.
