Determination:

There was a conflict of evidence in this case. The only documentation furnished was a form P45, by the Appellant. The Tribunal finds that a redundancy situation existed and the appeal under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003, succeeds. Accordingly, the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum payment according to the following criteria:

Employment commenced: 06th July 2003
Employment ceased: 26th October 2007
Gross pay: €754.15

Please note that this award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period and noting that there is a statutory gross weekly ceiling of €600.00.
