**Determination:**

The Tribunal finds that a redundancy situation existed and the appeal under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003, succeeds. Accordingly, the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum payment according to the following criteria:

Employment commenced: 01 September 2004  
Employment ceased: 06 July 2007  
Gross pay: €140.00

Please note that this award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period and that there is a statutory gross weekly ceiling of €600.00.
