The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:

Determination:

As the Respondent's representative was unable to get adequate instructions from his clients, the evidence of the Claimant was uncontested.

Accordingly, the Tribunal him finds that he is entitled to a redundancy lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003, based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth:	23 November 1987
Date employment commenced:	02 May 2004
Date employment ended:	01 January 2007
Gross weekly salary	€229.50

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

It also awards him €459.00 (being the equivalent of 2 weeks pay) under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2001.
