Determination:

It was agreed by both parties that the claimant ceased work on 3rd January 2008. He was offered alternative work, first in Waterford and then in Kilkenny. He declined these offers because they were too far away. The Tribunal finds that a redundancy situation took place and accordingly the appellant is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003, based on the following criteria:

Date of Termination:	3 rd January 2008
Gross Weekly Pay:	€ 600.00
