The determination of the Tribunal was as follows:

Determination:

Based on the uncontroverted evidence of the appellant the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003 based on the following criteria

Date of Birth	17 April 1966
Employment commenced	30 March 1994
Employment ended	4 January 2008
Gross weekly pay	€625-00

It should be noted that payments from the social insurance fund are limited to a maximum of €600-00 per week. This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

Loss having been established the Tribunal further awards €3,750-00, being six weeks' pay under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2003
