The determination of the Tribunal was as follows:

Determination:

The Tribunal, being satisfied that the respondent was properly on notice of the hearing, proceeded to hear the claims. At the outset of proceedings the claimant's representative withdrew the claim by the first named claimant under the Unfair Dismissals Acts. On the uncontroverted evidence of the claimants the Tribunal finds that the first named claimant is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003 based on the following criteria.
