The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

Determination

The respondent PK told the Tribunal that the appellant informed him on a number of occasions that he was not going to continue working for him. He agreed to meet the appellant on 29 February 2008. The appellant signed a form requesting his P45 and PK gave the appellant his P45. After the 29 February 2008 the appellant did not work for the respondent and he is currently unemployed. He is in receipt of unemployment benefit.

On the evidence presented to the Tribunal there was no case to be heard and the appeal under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003 fails.
