The Tribunal is satisfied that the respondents were properly notified of this hearing. Neither they nor representatives on their behalf appeared for this hearing.

Having heard submissions from the appellant the Tribunal finds that his employment was terminated by way of redundancy by the respondents. Accordingly, the appeal under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003 succeeds and a redundancy lump sum is awarded based on the following:

Gross Weekly Wage: €775.25

Redundancy payments are subject to a weekly ceiling of €600.00 including payments from the Social Insurance Fund.
