Based on the uncontested evidence of the appellant, the Tribunal finds that she is entitled to a redundancy lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003 based on the following details:

Date of Birth10 November 1972Date employment commenced26 January 2003Date employment ended17 June 2007Gross weekly salary€332.50

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

The Tribunal also awards her €332.50 (being the equivalent of 1 weeks pay) under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2001.

As claims made under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003 and the Unfair Dismissals Acts, 1977 to 2001 are mutually exclusive, the claim under the Unfair Dismissals Acts, 1977 to 2001, fails.

No award is made under the Organisation of Working Time Act, 1997.
