## **Determination**

The appellant told the Tribunal that his employment ended on the 9 July 2008. He endeavoured to contact his employer to seek his redundancy entitlement but his telephone calls were not returned.

On the uncontested evidence of the appellant the Tribunal is satisfied that the appellant is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003 based on the following criteria:

Date of birth13 November 1957Date employment commenced13 March 2006Date employment ended9 July 2008Gross weekly pay€1067.32

The award is being made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

Please note that there is a weekly ceiling of €600 on all awards made from the Social Insurance Fund.
