Determination

Based on the uncontested evidence of the appellants the Tribunal is satisfied that the appellants were dismissed without having received their minimum notice entitlements. Accordingly the Tribunal determines that the first named appellant is entitled to payment of €1680.00 being theequivalent of four weeks wages under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts 1973to 2001.

In relation to the second named appellant the Tribunal determines that she is entitled to payment of €750.00 being the equivalent of two weeks wages under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts 1973 to 2001.
