Based on the uncontroverted evidence of the appellant the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003 based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth Employment commenced Employment ended Gross weekly pay 24<sup>th</sup> July 1972 29<sup>th</sup> March 2004 7<sup>th</sup> December 2007 €752.92

It should be noted that a statutory weekly ceiling of €600.00 currently applies to payments from the Social Insurance Fund.
