The decision of the Tribunal was as follows: -

This case came before the Tribunal by way of an appeal of the Rights Commissioner's recommendation; dated 29th February 2008, reference r-052304-te-07/MH.

The Appellant admitted that he had been in breech of Section 3 of the Terms of Employment (Information) Act, 1994. He was appealing the decision of the Right's Commissioner on the grounds that the penalty awarded was unduly harsh.

The respondent argued that the appellant was in breech of the Act and that the penalty was appropriate in the circumstances.

Determination

The Tribunal carefully considered the evidence given and the submissions made to it. The Tribunal decided that the appropriate award to make is €700.00. The recommendation of the Right's Commissioner is varied.
