There was no dispute that a redundancy situation existed. The Tribunal extends the time within which the appellant can lodge his appeal. The Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003 based on the following criteria

Date of Birth11 February 1961Employment commenced29 March 2004Employment ended29 June 2007Gross weekly pay€788.72

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

It should be noted that payments from the social insurance fund are limited to a maximum of $\[\epsilon 600-00 \]$ per week.
