The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:

At the outset of this hearing the appeal under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2001 was withdrawn.

The Tribunal noted that the appeal under the Redundancy Payment Acts, 1967 to 2007 was conceded by the respondent.
