The fact of redundancy being conceded by the respondent the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria.

Dismissal notice received 3 April 2009 Employment ended 3 April 2009 Gross weekly pay €1,100-00

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period. It should be noted that payments from the social insurance

fund are limited to a maximum of €600-00 per week

The evidence having shown that the appellant received one week's notice of termination, the Tribunal further awards €1,100-00, being one week's pay, under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2003.
