It being conceded at the outset of proceedings that the appellant had served the respondent with a claim for a redundancy lump sum payment on account of his being laid-off for four consecutive weeks, and that the respondent did not issue counter notice, the Tribunal is satisfied that the appellant is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003 based on the following criteria

Date of Birth16 December 1978Employment commenced23 January 2006Employment ended22 June 2008Gross weekly pay€850-00

Payments from the social insurance fund are limited to a maximum of €600-00 per week. This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
