## **Determination**

The claimant told the Tribunal that she commenced work with the respondent on 13 October 2007. She started work between 6.00a.m. and 6.30a.m. She made the breakfast, cleaned the restaurant and the rooms. She did not attend a hygiene course as she had a medical appointment. She was told that Friday was her last day of work. She was later told that she should return to work and when she returned to work on Friday 8 February 2008 her employment was terminated.

On the uncontested evidence of the claimant the Tribunal is satisfied that the claimant's

employment terminated without notice and awards the claimant compensation in the amount of €360.00 which is equivalent to one week's gross pay under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2001.
