The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

The respondent conceded that a redundancy situation existed. The Tribunal awards the appellant a redundancy lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003 based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth:	13 th July 1980
Date of Commencement:	13 th March 2006
Date of Termination:	28 th April 2008
Gross Pay:	€ 722.00

It should be noted that a statutory weekly ceiling of €600.00 applies to payments from the Social Insurance Fund. This award is made subject to the appellant fulfilling current social welfare requirements in relation to PRSI contributions.
