The determination of the Tribunal was as follows:-

Respondent's Case

VH for the respondent company told the Tribunal that he paid the claimant four weeks notice. There is a claim pending for the claimant in the Department of Enterprise, Trade and Employment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003. The respondent went into liquidation recently.

Determination

The Tribunal is satisfied that the notice of hearing was received at the claimant's address. Based on the uncontested evidence of the respondent the Tribunal is satisfied that the claimant has been paid his minimum notice and his redundancy payment is currently being dealt with. Therefore his claims under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2001, Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003 and the Unfair Dismissals Acts, 1977 to 2001 are dismissed.
