The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:

At the outset of the hearing the managing director (MD) of the respondent company agreed that the appellant had been made redundant and was entitled to a redundancy payment. However, MD stated that he was unable to pay the lump sum. The appellant gave evidence that he received a letter, which told him he was being laid off on 3rd September. He agreed that his P45 stated that his last day of employment was 7th September 2007. The appellant received no payment in lieu of notice.

Having heard the evidence adduced the Tribunal is satisfied that a redundancy situation occurred and award the appellant a redundancy lump sum payment based on the following criteria:

Date of Commencement: 23rd May 2005 Date of Termination: 7th September 2007

Gross weekly pay: €622.83

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period

The Tribunal finds that the claim under the Minimum Notice And Terms Of Employment Act 1973 To 2001 succeeds and awards the appellant €1245.66 (one thousand, two-hundred and forty-five euro sixty-six cent).

It should be noted that payments from the Social Insurance Fund are limited to a maximum of €600.00 per week.
