The appellant was placed on temporary lay-off on  $3^{\rm rd}$  November 2008 and he was made redundant on  $18^{\rm th}$  December 2008

## **Determination**

The Tribunal is satisfied that the respondent was duly notified of the hearing. Based on the uncontested evidence of the appellant the Tribunal finds the he is entitled to a redundancy lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003 based on the following criteria:

Date of birth14th December 1974Date employment commenced04th February 2002Date employment ceased18th December 2008Gross weekly pay€1,000.00

Please note that a statutory weekly ceiling of €600 applies to all payments from the Social Insurance Fund.

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

The claim under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2001 and the Organisation of Working Time Act, 1997 were withdrawn by the appellant as these claims are being dealt with by a Rights Commissioner.
