The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

Determination

Appeals under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003 must be submitted to the secretariat of the Employment Appeals Tribunal within fifty-two weeks of the appellant's date of termination. Appeals, lodged after the aforesaid period but within the period of one hundred and four weeks from the date of dismissal, may be considered subject to the appellant demonstrating reasonable cause for the delay in furnishing such an application within the time limit.

The appellant's date of termination was 7th April 2006 and the appeal was lodged with the Tribunal on 26th September 2008. Accordingly, the Tribunal has no jurisdiction to hear the appeal under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003.
