The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

The appellant was placed on temporary lay-off on 3^{rd} November 2008 and he was made redundant on 7^{th} November 2008.

Determination:

The Tribunal is satisfied that the respondent was duly notified of the hearing. Based on the uncontested evidence of the appellant the Tribunal finds that he is entitled to a redundancy lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003 based on the following criteria:

Date of birth 05th June 1969
Date employment commenced 15th April 2004
Date employment ceased 07th November 2008

Gross weekly pay €1,201.92

Please note that a statutory weekly ceiling of €600 applies to all payments made from the Social Insurance Fund.

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

The claim under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2001 was withdrawn by the appellant as this matter is being dealt with by a Rights Commissioner.
