Determination:

The receivers, present at the hearing, conceded the appeals under the above Acts. Accordingly, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003, based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth:	10 th March 1956
Date employment commenced:	24th August 2004
Date employment ended:	15th August 2008
Gross weekly salary	€599.82

Under the Minimum Notice and Terms Of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2001, the Tribunal awards the appellant the sum of €1,199.64, this being the equivalent of two weeks gross pay, as compensation in lieu of notice.

Please note that a statutory gross weekly ceiling limit of €600.00 currently applies to payments from the Social Insurance Fund. These awards are made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
