The respondent conceded that a redundancy situation existed. The Tribunal awards the appellant a redundancy lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, based on the following criteria:

Date of Commencement: 15<sup>th</sup> May 2005  
Date of Termination: 11<sup>th</sup> June 2008  
Gross Weekly Pay: €700.00

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period. It should be noted that a statutory weekly ceiling of €600.00 applies to payments from the Social Insurance Fund.
