The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

Determination:

There was no appearance by or on behalf of the respondent. However, in advance of the hearing the respondent wrote to the Tribunal indicating that he did not dispute that the appellant had been made redundant.

Based on the appellant's uncontested evidence, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003 based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth:	8 th March 1973
Date of Commencement:	1 st April 2001
Date of Termination:	31 st January 2008
Gross Weekly Wage:	€450.00
