The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

## **Preliminary Point**

The claim under the Unfair Dismissals Acts 1977 to 2001 was withdrawn on the day of the hearing.

## Determination

The Tribunal notes that there were multiple breaks in the claimant's service throughout the period of two years and eight months of his association with the respondent. Specifically the Tribunal notes that a P45 was issued by the respondent on the 17 October 2006. The Tribunal is not persuaded that the claimant provided the respondent with written notice of intention to claim a redundancy payment as required under section 12 of the Redundancy Payments Act 1967.

Accordingly the claim under the Redundancy Payments Acts 1967 to 2003 fails.

The Tribunal was not given any credible evidence in support of the claimant's claim for relief under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts 1973 to 2001. Accordingly this claim also fails.
