The claim under Unfair Dismissals Acts, 1977 To 2001 was withdrawn during the hearing.

The Respondent conceded the claim under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2001, loss having been established, the Tribunal awards the claimant €1660.00, being two weeks' pay.
