The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

Appellant's case:

In direct evidence, the appellant confirmed the details of his employment with the respondent, as set out on his T1-A form (*Notice of Appeal*).

Respondent's case:

The respondent confirmed that he was not contesting the appellant's redundancy claim but has an inability to pay same.

Determination:

Accepting the uncontested evidence, the Tribunal finds that the claim under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003 succeeds and awards the appellant a redundancy lump sum, which is to be calculated on the basis of the following criteria:

Date employment commenced	18 April 2005

Date of notice Date employment ended Gross weekly wage 29 August 2008 13 September 2008 €807.69

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
