The respondent informed the Tribunal that he had received a rebate in respect of the appellant's redundancy lump sum payment but had not paid the appellant his entitlement. The respondent stated that the appellant had signed the RP50 redundancy form.

The appellant did not recall signing the RP50 form and had not received his redundancy lump sum.

The Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria:
