The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:

The director of the company conceded that a redundancy situation existed in relation to the termination of the appellant's employment. Accordingly, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth:	08 th November 1980
Date of Commencement:	02 nd June 2003
Date of Termination:	22 nd February 2008
Gross Weekly Pay:	€808.86

It should be noted that a statutory weekly ceiling of €600.00 currently applies to payments from the Social Insurance Fund.

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social

Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
