The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

Determination:

The Tribunal is satisfied that the respondent and the liquidator were duly notified of this hearing. Neither the respondent nor a representative on his behalf appeared at the hearing. Based on the appellant's uncontroverted evidence, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth:	7 August 1951
Date of Commencement:	14 March 2005
Date of Cessation:	6 November 2007
Date of Termination:	21 November 2007
Gross Weekly Wage:	€874.34

It should be noted that a statutory weekly ceiling of €600.00 currently applies to payments from the Social Insurance fund.

This award is made subject to the appellant fulfilling current social welfare requirements in relation to PRSI contributions.
