The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:

The respondent conceded that a redundancy situation existed. The Tribunal awards the appellant a redundancy lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payment Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria:

Date of Commencement: 6<sup>th</sup> April 1985  
Date of Termination: 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2008  
Gross Weekly Pay: €700.00

It should be noted that a statutory weekly ceiling of €600.00 applies to payments from the Social Insurance Fund.

The appellant withdrew his claim under the Organisation of Working Time Act, 1997, at the hearing.
