The Tribunal is satisfied that the respondent was properly notified of this hearing. Neither the respondent nor a representative on his behalf appeared for this hearing.

Having considered the appellant's submission the Tribunal finds that the respondent did not furnish him with his written terms and conditions of employment within the stipulated two months following the commencement of his employment.

Accordingly, the recommendation of the rights commissioner is upset and the Tribunal awards the appellant €1841.30 as compensation under the Terms of Employment (Information) Act, 1994 and 2001.
