The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

Determination

The Tribunal is satisfied that the appellant was dismissed by reason of redundancy. In view of the fact that information requested by the Tribunal from the respondent at the hearing was not forthcoming, the Tribunal awards the appellant a redundancy lump payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth:	25 August 1959
Date of commencement of employment:	6 April 1998
Date of termination of employment:	1 January 2009
Gross weekly pay:	€700.00

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

Please note that there is a weekly ceiling of €600.00 on all awards made from the Social Insurance Fund.
