Determination

Based on the appellant's uncontroverted evidence, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth:	8 th May 1973
Date of Commencement:	3 rd October 2000
Date of Termination:	20 th June 2008
Gross Weekly Wage:	€313.28

It should be noted that a statutory weekly ceiling of €600.00 currently applies to payments from the Social Insurance Fund. These awards are made subject to the appellant fulfilling current social welfare requirements in relation to PRSI contributions
