Based on the uncontroverted evidence of the appellant the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003 based on the following criteria

Date of Birth Employment commenced Employment ended Gross weekly pay 06 March1964 09th January 2006 26th October 2008 €2,884.62

It should be noted that payments from the social insurance fund are limited to a maximum of €600-00 per week. This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurableemployment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

Loss having been established the Tribunal further awards €5,769.24, this being compensation of two weeks' pay, under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2003

The Tribunal makes an award under the Organisation of Working Time Act, 1997, of €9,247.49.
