## Determination

Based on the uncontested evidence of the appellant the Tribunal finds that she is entitled to a redundancy lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2005, based on the following criteria:

Date of birth 10 April 1981
Date employment commenced 19 June 1999
Date employment ceased 07 November 2008

Gross weekly pay €769.23

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

The Tribunal further awards the appellant the sum of €3076.92 (being the equivalent of 4 weeks pay) under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005.

It should be noted that payments from the social insurance fund are limited to a maximum of  $\[ \in \]$  600.00 per week.
