The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

The respondent conceded the appellant's entitlement to redundancy, but said that he had insufficient funds with which to pay him.

Determination:

Based on the uncontested evidence of the appellant, the Tribunal finds that he is entitled to a redundancy lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003 based on the following details:

Date of Birth	23 June 1972
Date employment commenced	15 June 2002
Date employment ended	14 March 2008
Gross weekly salary	€640.00

(It should be noted that payments from the social insurance fund are limited to a maximum of €600.00 per week.)

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
