The respondent conceded the appellant's entitlement to redundancy but said that there was a period of 9 weeks non–reckonable pay (45 days) in relation to unscheduled leave. This was accepted by the appellant.

## **Determination:**

Based on the uncontested evidence of the appellant, the Tribunal finds that he is entitled to a redundancy lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003 based on the following
