The claim under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts 1973 to 2005 was withdrawn at the outset of the hearing.

The respondent conceded that a redundancy situation existed and the Tribunal awards the appellant a redundancy lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria:

Date of termination of employment: 18 October 2008

Gross weekly pay: €719.95
