The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:

In his evidence to the Tribunal, the Director of the Respondent Company conceded that the Appellant was entitled to a redundancy payment. It appeared that the Director had endeavoured to restructure the Respondent Company to no avail and that no further work could be offered to the Appellant. The evidence of the Respondent's Director was that due to financial difficulties the company was unable to pay the Appellant's redundancy entitlement to him.

Determination:

Accordingly, the Tribunal unanimously determined that the Appellant is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, based on the following agreed criteria:

Date of Birth: 26th June 1961
Date of Commencement: 24th January 2005
Date of Termination: 24th January 2008

Gross Weekly Pay: €500.00
