The determination of the Tribunal was as follows:

## **Determination**

The respondent having conceded the fact of redundancy the Tribunal finds that the claimant is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria

Date of Birth 16 July 1979 Employment commenced 11 May 2005 Employment ended 17 November 2008

Gross weekly pay €650-00

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period. It should be noted that payments from the social insurance

fund are limited to a maximum of €600-00 per week.

The Tribunal further awards €1,300-00, being two weeks' pay, under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005. The claim under the Unfair Dismissals Acts, 1977 to 2007 was withdrawn.
