Determination:

Based on the uncontested evidence of the first named appellant the Tribunal finds that he was dismissed by reason of redundancy on 30 September 2008. Accordingly, the Tribunal determines that the first named appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following information:
