Determination:

This hearing was scheduled to commence at 2.30pm. The Tribunal waited until 2.45pm before commencing proceedings. The Tribunal was satisfied that the appellant and respondent were duly notified of the hearing by registered post. However, there was no appearance by them, or representation on their behalf.

On the instructions on the Tribunal, the secretary contacted the appellant by telephone. The appellant informed the secretary that he had been paid his redundancy and had received a cheque for same at the end of May. He therefore had no requirement for the Tribunal to pursue the redundancy claim.

As there was no attendance by or on behalf of the appellant, the appeal under the Redundancy
