Determination:

The Tribunal is satisfied that the respondent was properly on notice of this hearing. Neither the respondent nor a representative on their behalf appeared at the hearing.

The appellant stated that he received the sum of €1977.00 being part payment of his redundancy lump sum entitlement from the respondent.

Based on the appellant's uncontested evidence, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is therefore entitled to the balance of his redundancy lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria:

Date of Termination:	4 th September 2008
Gross Weekly Wage:	€618.00
It should be noted that a statutory weekly ceiling of \in 600.00 currently applies to payments from the Social Insurance Fund.	
This award is made subject to the appellant fulfilling current social welfare requirements in relation to PRSI contributions.	
The Tribunal also awards the appellant €1236.00 being the equivalent of two weeks gross pay under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005.
