The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

Determination:

The Tribunal is satisfied that the respondent was properly on notice of this hearing. Neither the respondent nor a representative on their behalf appeared at this hearing.

Based on the appellant's uncontested evidence, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth:	22 nd April 1980
Date of Commencement:	6 th September 2006
Date of Termination:	30 th September 2008
Gross Weekly Wage:	€833.33

It should be noted that a statutory weekly ceiling of €600.00 currently applies to payments from the Social Insurance Fund.

This award is made subject to the appellant fulfilling current social welfare requirements in relation to PRSI contributions.
